

## EASY - TO - MAKE ARTIST STATEMENT POSTER

Visitors to the Gallery enjoy reading an artist statement or anything an artist wants to share about the work on display. Below a simple but effective way to do this without the help of expensive poster design companies.

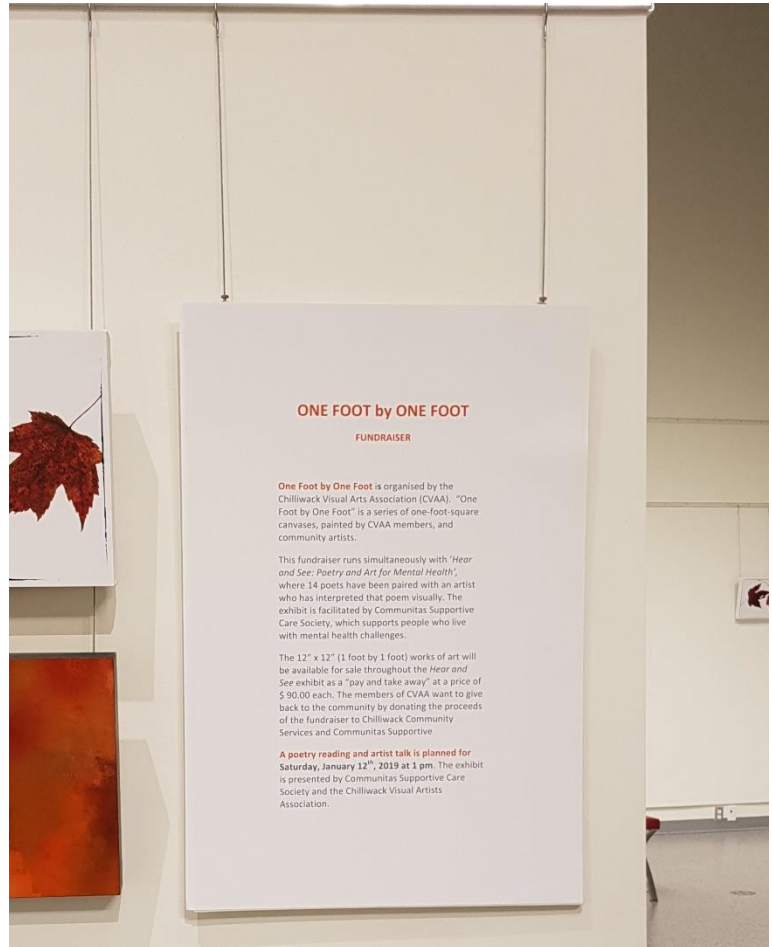
If you are planning on having an artist talk during the exhibition period, invite visitors to come and include the date and time on the poster.

### Supplies needed:

White Quick Stick Foam board 20" x 30"  
two O-rings

1. Format your text/pictures in a letter size document.  
In this example the margins of the letter-size document were set smaller on both sides.
2. Save it on a memory stick and bring it to Staples.
3. Buy a White Quick Stick Foam board 20" x 30" at Staples.
4. Bring it to the printing counter together with your stick and ask them to print your document in a bigger size, a size that fits the foam. Usually it is a 1- or 2 day service.

5. Peel of the adhesive from foam and starting at the top stick your print on the foam.
6. Since it is so light tape 2 rings on the back of the board (in this example taped with masking tape) and hang it on the gallery wires.
